- COURTS. All weather, artificial grass and clay courts will be used at the Club. Other courts near the Club may also be
- DRAW will take place at the Clubhouse on Monday 26th March 2007. 5.
- CHALLENGE CUPS cannot be won outright and must be returned to the Club Secretary, The East Glos Club, Old 6. Bath Road, Cheltenham, GL53 7DF before the start of the following years Tournament. Cups must not be taken outside the U.K.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- The Tournament promoted by The East Gloucestershire Club is sanctioned by the L.T.A. under whose current rules, regulations, and code of conduct, it will be run.
- Players may enter more than one tournament event in overlapping periods, provided there is no conflict of 2. requirements between tournaments and that the Referee of each tournament gives approval.
- The Committee reserves the right to alter or modify the programme and conditions subject to compliance with the 3. L.T.A. rules and to refuse any entry.
- Players are restricted to a maximum entry of THREE EVENTS OF WHICH ONLY TWO MAY BE SINGLES. Singles are to be restricted to a 40 draw (10U events to a 32 draw). Selection will be based on ratings and ranking. Players entering two singles events must be prepared to play several matches on one day.
- WITHDRAWALS. The withdrawal deadline is 4 DAYS (96 hours) before the start of the Tournament. Withdrawal 5. procedure as specified in the current L.T.A. Tournament Regulations will apply.
- I, the parent/guardian, consent to: 6.
 - the player participating in doping control procedures if selected, undertaken by an independent sampling officer (ISO) appointed by UK Sports.
 - (ii) the player being involved in any publicity connected with LTA Staged Tournaments, including media interviews, photographs and TV footage. Please inform the tournament organiser if you do not wish the player to be involved in publicity.
 - (iii) the details provided on this entry form to be used to update the LTA Advantage Club Membership record of the person identified.
 - (iv) the LTA and/or LTA Sanction Tournament Organisers, from my geographical area, using the details provided on the entry form to communicate information about this and future tournaments, in my geographical area, via post/email or SMS.

TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

- A staggered draw will be used for all singles events, with a round robin qualifier for the 10u events. 1
- MATCH FORMAT Matches will normally be the best of 3 tie-break sets except 12U and 10U events which will normally 2. be 2 tie-break sets with any 3rd set a match tie-break.
- 3. PLATE EVENTS. If weather and time permits, plate events may be offered except for 10u events. These events are for first match losers only, and only those who are not still involved in the main draw.
- TENNIS CLOTHING: Competitors must play in recognised tennis clothing and shoes. Unless authorised by the 4. referee, track suits must be removed before the start of play.
- START TIMES: 5.

Play each day will normally be between 9.30 a.m. - 6.00 p.m., but may be extended by the referee.

Competitors who are not ready when called may be scratched. Competitors must not leave the ground without 6. ascertaining the time of their next match.

- ATTENDANCE SHEETS MUST BE COMPLETED BY ALL COMPETITORS ON ARRIVAL EACH DAY. 7. Players failing to sign the attendance sheet are liable to be scratched by the Referee.
- No complaint in connection with the Tournament can be entertained by the Committee unless in writing and 8. lodged with the Secretary within 48 hours of the occurrence with a copy to the County Tournament Coordinator. Leave to appeal against a Committee decision must similarly be lodged with the L.T.A. Head of Officiating within 10 days of such decision.
